## Confinement, if appealed, until final determination:

You or your attorney may request from the court that the designated dog be held in the possession of the owner until the court makes a final determination. Until the court makes a final determination and during the pendency of any appeal, the dog must be confined or restrained in accordance with the provisions described under "Confinement of dangerous dogs".

If your dog is confined at the Dog Warden Facility you are required by law to provide a security of \$100.00 for expenses incurred in keeping the dog during the appeal, failure to provide this security will result in forfeiture of the dog. When the court action has been completed the dog owner will be given, within 10 days after the court's final determination, an "actual cost" of confinement and the dog owner shall remit the difference within 30 days of the court's final determination.
